Educational and Professional Guidance to build the future

To be held on November the 29th, 30th and December 1st, 2017

at Auditorium "Dr. Raoul Fournier Villada" of the Faculty of Medicine, UNAM

The International Conference of Educational and Professional Guidance 2017 bring together the Second National University Conference of Educational Guidance, the International Conference of Guidance IAEVG/AIOEP 2017 and the 11th National Conference of Educational and Vocational Guidance, AMPO'2017.

PURPOSE

To analyze and discuss the approaches and contributions of Educational and Vocational Guidance, public and institutional policies and their relationship with current demands in today's world, as well as the challenges that affect daily life, the educational and professional trajectories of young people; to promote the construction of new strategies and interventions across different levels of education that will prepare the new generations for social change and transformation with a sense of responsibility and ethical commitment.

TOPICS

- I. Institutional Policies and educational guidance:
Social rights, inclusion, health, disability, discrimination, migration, gender equality and sustainable development.
- II. Intervention in educational and vocational guidance:
Innovative educational and vocational guidance approaches, intervention and programs appropriate for individuals and groups, including the use of ICT.
- III. Young people of the 21st century and their guidance and counselling needs related to: citizenship and school bullying, well-being and dignity, mental health, sexual and reproductive services, challenges in using ICT and social networks, transition to adulthood, perspectives for educational, social and economic development.
- IV. Training, professionalization, identity and social engagement the guidance practitioners and counsellors:
Updating of educational and training programs for guidance practitioners, counsellors and careers advisers in different fields and educational levels and across educational levels
- V. Influence of changing labour market opportunities on ways of working:
Analysis of new scenarios and ways of working, as well as, the labour market.

ADDRESSED TO

Educational, vocational and career practitioners and counsellors, faculty, professionals and students interested in this discipline may participate.
The official languages of the Conference are Spanish and English, simultaneous translation to English will be offered at the Keynote speeches and activities that require it.

PROCEDURE TO PARTICIPATE

- Those interested in presenting papers, posters and self-organized symposia, book presentations and educational material, may send their proposals using forms available at <http://www.orienta.unam.mx/congreso/registro> As of the publication of this call.
- Each author may register up to two papers, as sole author or co-author, in any of the modalities.
- Deadline for receiving papers: May the 31st 2017 (24:00 UTC/GMT -6 hour, Mexico City).
- The papers will be reviewed by the scientific committee. A notice of acceptance, will be sent via email, no later than August the 31st, 2017.
- The publication date of the Academic Program will be October the 31st, 2017.

CRITERIA FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF PAPERS

We will receive reports of studies, research in progress or concluded, descriptions of intervention experiences and original essays in Spanish or English, unpublished, at the following address: <http://www.orienta.unam.mx/congreso/registro> with the following specifications:

PARALLEL PAPERS

1. Identification and summary data
 - Title of paper
 - Main topic
 - Author's name (up to three)
 - Authors' emails
 - Institution to which it belongs
 - Abstract /from 250 to 300 words maximum
 - Keywords: minimum of three (3) and a maximum of five (5).
 - The reports of studies, research and intervention experiences should consist of introduction, objectives, approaches, methodology, results, conclusions and bibliographical references.
 - Essays will include introduction, development, conclusions and bibliographical references.
 - The paper can be written in English or Spanish.
 - Bibliographic references in APA format <http://normasapa.com/citas/>
 - Total length of 6 to 10 pages, including tables, graphs, bibliographical references and attachments.
 - No footers or headers.
 - Tables and notes should be placed at the end of the text and before the bibliographic references
2. Format
 - Arial font of 11 points and line spacing of 1.5.
 - Word processor, version 6.0.
3. Presentation of papers
 - Presentation time will be up to 15 minutes.
 - Electronic presentation materials must be sent (Power Point via e-mail) to the Academic Coordinator of the Session eight days before of the date the presentation.

SELF-ORGANIZED SYMPOSIUM

- The topics of the proposed symposium should be linked to the theme of the Conference and be of interest to the discipline of Educational and Vocational Guidance
- The coordinator of the symposium must register it, including the papers (complete) of the authors involved in the symposium.
- Each symposium will have a maximum of four papers and a minimum of three.
- The duration of each symposium will be seventy-five minutes.
- The registration of a symposium proposal should be made at <http://www.orienta.unam.mx/congreso/registro>, Once accepted, the electronic presentations materials in PowerPoint of each participant will be combined into one file which will be sent to the Academic Coordinator of the Session eight days before the date of presentation.

POSTERS

The poster proposals must be registered online, through the Conference site to the following address: <http://www.orienta.unam.mx/congreso/registro> according to the following specifications:

4. Identification data
 - Title of the poster
 - Topic of the contribution.
 - Name of authors; maximum three
 - Overall summary, no more than 250 words.
 - Keywords: maximum five.
 - Results and bibliographic references APA.
 - The summary text will have an extension of 3-4 pages, Arial format 11 points, line spacing 1.5, in Word and will be sent to include in the Act of the Conference.
 - The poster will have a vertical design with the following measures .90 cm (width) and 120 cm (length).
 - The authors will present their posters to attendees at the scheduled session on November 30, in the Auditorium Lobby "Raoul Fournier" of the Faculty of Medicine in University City.

BOOK PRESENTATION AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL

Proposals for the presentations of books or educational material will be send via email: congresoorienta2017@gmail.com with the following specifications:

- Topics linked to Educational and Vocational Guidance and themes of the Conference
 - Published from 2014 to 2017 and ISBN, no presented in former events
 - A brief biographical sketch of authors
 - Review of the book or educational material
- If there is an electronic version of book, it will be sent the link in Dropbox or Google Drive; if not, you may send two copies of the book or material, to: Dirección de Orientación, DGOAE, UNAM. Circuito Escolar, Entre Facultades de Arquitectura e Ingeniería, Ciudad Universitaria, Coyoacán, Cd. Mx. C.P. 04510.

The presentation will be in a round table that will be 80 minutes in length.

5. The Scientific Committee will evaluate the paper using the following criteria:
 - Pertinence to the proposed topic.
 - Originality.
 - Relevance to the development of Educational and Vocational Guidance.
 - Quality of contents.
 - Compliance with the requirements established in points 1 and 2 of this Call for Papers.
6. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject any paper that does not comply with the requirements stated above and will not include it in the final Program of the Conference if registration payment has not been made prior to October 20, 2017.
7. Copyright
 - The papers are exclusive responsibility of author's. They do not represent the opinion of the Organizing Committee.
 - The original papers must be accompanied by the Assignment of Rights form available in the Registration, signed by authors.
8. Presenters of papers are not exempt from payment of registration fees for the Conference. If the speakers, for a justified reason, cannot attend the Conference, they must inform the Scientific Committee before the date and time of their presentation. The Scientific Committee may allow another participant to read the speaker's paper.
